

Bishop's Post December 22 January 23 Bible for the road ...

"Beer-Lachai-Roï" Genesis 16,14

No, this is not the name of a beer, but indeed of a drinking place - a water well in the desert. Hagar chose the name, because at this well the Lord spoke to her when she was ready to give up on everything. The "well of the Living One who sees me" (English translation) became the turning point in her life. At this well she realised that God not only sees her, but appreciates her and has a plan for her.

The watchword for 2023 is the preceding verse. The reason why I chose this specific verse is because it is also the daily Bible reading for 31 January 2023, the date of my official retirement, a turning point in my own life.

This is the last Bishop's Post that I am writing. I look back at 13 years as bishop of NELCSA, and also remember how 42 years ago I started my practical year in Verden-Dundee. And now I am reaching another major turning point. For NELCSA it is the turning point where, for the next 7 years, you will walk with Bishop Theo Jäckel.

As I end my term, I want to leave you with a special gift: The well "Beer-Lachai-Roï". I started drinking from this well when I was 10 years old. That is when I discovered a Bible in a shelf and started reading on a daily basis. Many times since then I experienced in my reading that God is seeing me, guiding me, appreciating me. Especially when I was facing difficult situations it was amazing to then realise: God is speaking to me now, God knows, God guides.

A well is useless if we don't drink from it. The Bible is silent if we don't read in it. "Beer-Lachai-Roï" - may this well be a place for you where you come to drink every day, and may you too receive strength and encouragement as you drink from it!

- 3. The Synod in October 2023 marks the beginning of a new Synod cycle of six years and the end of term for all current delegates. All congregations are requested to elect new synod delegates at their annual general meetings in 2023.

We thank him and his wife Gudrun for the many years that they served in NELCSA: 1998-2004 in Moorleigh-Winterton, 2010-18 in New Hannover and 2019-2022 in Kempton Park. May the Lord guide and strengthen them as they move to their new (Gudrun) and old (Dieter) home country.
- 5. As a result of the above, both Kroondal and Kempton Park congregations will be vacant as from January 2023. May the Lord guide the process of filling the post. In view of the shortage of pastors the words of Jesus become even more important: "The workers are few, the work is plenty. Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send workers into the field".
- 6. On 2 February Hermann Düvel is taking his First Theological Examination in Stellenbosch. If everything goes well he will then start his first year of internship, as arranged by the United Evangelical Lutheran Church in Southern Africa.
