"There is a longing in our hearts, o Lord for you to reveal yourself to us." The song by Ann Quigley expresses this longing in a range of life-situations. The longing to be close to Christ, to be guided, comforted, encouraged.

It is wonderful to realise that God has the same longing. That is why he decided to become human and touchable. He became a baby, carried in the arms of his parents, Hannah, Simeon and many others.

Jesus, in turn, when he was an adult, took time to embrace children brought to him (Mark 10, 16). The statue (by Karin Rabe) shows the deep peace on the faces of Jesus and children in his presence.

After almost two years of physical distancing many people also have this longing for touch, embracing, closeness. It is good to find safe ways to be in touch and to make use of them.

When doing so, let us remember our Lord, who could no longer stand to be at a distance, and became human to be with us. We celebrate this especially at Christmas and Epiphany (6 January). We also experience it at baptism, when the water

touches us, at communion, when we taste and see Christ in the elements and fellowship. And we can feel the touch when we are blessed with laying on of hands (which can be done safely even in Corona times). Not only the pastor can do it. When we pray with our children, let us lay our hands on them. When we

pray in the family, let us lay our hands on each other with words of blessing. Through all this we can experience that the Lord is dwelling amongst us. May his peace and presence surround you this Christmas and as we start the year Most Mulle 2022.
