


Where is Mkondo/Commondale?



Historic Background

- Initiated in 2005 by Markus Kallembach, serving in the Igwa circuit of ELCSA, together with mission committees of Augsburg and Braunschweig (ELKSA-N-T) congregations
- High incidence of HIV & AIDS on farms
- Little help, poor health services, lack of information
- Initial emphasis on education and information
- Training of Peer Educators






