History

Thol'ulwazi Tholimpilo is a NGO Project initiated in 2005, when the number of HIV and Aids related incidents started escalating on farms in the Comondale area. It was initially a church driven project started by the Mission Committees of Braunschweig and Augsburg Lutheran Congregations. By offering effective education and de-stigmatization of the disease we hoped to make a difference.



Mission

Our most important function as organization is to offer education, support and assistance to the farm workers and their families in our target areas, especially in getting HCT and treatment available at the farm gate. In our continued efforts, together with the Dept. of Health and with the support of our various sponsors we shall endeavor to fulfill and reach this goal.

Peer Educators

In June 2007 we trained our first group of 40 Peer Educators. A further 80 peer educators were trained by AfriSIDA a Cape Town based training body. These 120 Peer Educators were trained on each farm where the owner was willing to get involved and support the initiative. Peers are active in the Comondale, Mondi farms along the Swaziland border, and the Iswepe/Panbult areas.
